



# Terms and conditions

## hertford360 event

By registering for hertford360, you are agreeing to abide by these terms and conditions.

If you choose the 'registration fee of £20 and fundraise' option, you must pay the entry fee at the time of signing up for the event. The entry fee will go towards the set-up costs for the event. All donations from your fundraising will go towards the charitable purpose of the event, which is student support (bursaries, scholarships, hardship grants and outreach). Your minimum fundraising target is £150, which you must reach by the end of the challenge: 31 July 2017.

If you opt for the monthly donation, please state on the registration form a convenient time for us to call to set this up – you must start this regular gift within one month from the time of registering. Your donation will go towards the charitable purpose of the event, which is student support (bursaries, scholarships, hardship grants and outreach). Although the

EverydayHero platform will automatically set up a fundraising page for you with a target of £150, this is optional for participants who have chosen the monthly donation option.

You are responsible for ensuring that you have undertaken any necessary preparation and training to enter and participate in any activity or race. Entry and participation in hertford360 is at your own risk – Hertford will take no responsibility for injury or accident. It is up to you to decide whether you are sufficiently fit and healthy to participate. If you are in doubt, we recommend that you seek medical advice.

Branded jerseys are available for purchase. These will be ordered from the supplier in batches and will be posted out to those who have purchased them once payment has been received and as we receive them from the supplier. It is your responsibility to ensure that we have your correct address for this to be posted to you.

## Personal data

*For the purposes of this section, personal information includes any data or information about you that is described as "personal data" and/or "sensitive personal data" in the Data Protection Act 1998 (which includes your name, photo and other information about you).*

### By signing up to these terms:

You agree that the Personal Information relating to you can be stored, used by us and our partners in connection with the organisation, staging and administration of the event.

You agree that the Personal Information relating to you may be anonymised and the anonymised data may be used by us in connection with the compilation of statistical information.

You agree that your contact details can be used by us to contact you by post, email or phone for the purposes of:

- The promotion and marketing of the event and the platform

- Updating you about the progress of the event and participants
- Keeping you informed about other similar fundraising initiatives, events or news
